## **Looking Back Thankfully**

Right after the Church became independent we began to prepare to buy a piece of land and to build the church building. The church building was built and completed in 1989. After that we split our fellowship into four fellowships, and separate the church worship into two, Chinese and English worship services. We started the fellowship lunch in the church. In 1995 we had our church expansion so that we had more space for classrooms, choir and fellowship meetings. Thank God, over the years BCBC had built up a number of missionaries, sent many missionaries and pastors to other towns and overseas to spread the gospel. In the last two years South Asians worship service was established in BCBC to spread the gospel to our neighbors.

## **Challenges of our Church in future**

BCBC is now a church with two languages and three dialects. In future BCBC will develop into a multi-cultural and multi-lingual church. Maintaining unity of the church is one of the biggest challenges in the multi-lingual environment with people from different cultural backgrounds.
